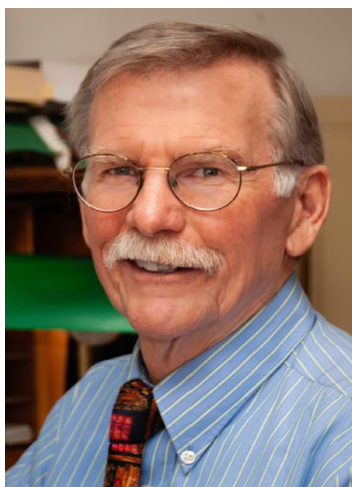
Kaylea Waechter (BA '13, CRTG '16, JD '16)
